



Webinar: Introducing Moodle Wiki

Objective

Using the Moodle Wiki in your course allows students to easily collaborate on a project together. The Wiki can be used for brainstorming ideas or even present their final product. This Webinar is intended to introduce instructors to using the Wiki activity in a Moodle course. We will demonstrate how to create and manage a Wiki so that your students can collaborate together through Moodle. This Webinar will focus on the technical considerations as well as the best practices. There will also be a discussion about creative uses of the Wiki.
